1. Purpose and Scope of Collection and Processing of Personal Data

In cases where the Firm is mandated by clients or required by law to transmit relevant personal data to specific recipients and regions (including but not limited to third parties mandated by the Firm to process personal data), the Firm will transmit it using appropriate Security Measures. If necessary, the Firm will require the data recipient to take measures no less stringent than the Firm's Security Measures to protect the received personal data through contractual clauses.

Despite the Security Measures taken by the Firm, data transmitted via the internet or stored in databases or other methods cannot be guaranteed to be 100% secure. Therefore, while the Firm will strive to protect your personal data with appropriate Security Measures, we cannot and do not guarantee or warrant the security of any personal data. We will not be and are not liable for any disclosure or leakage of personal data due to transmission errors, networks that are beyond our control or unauthorized actions by third parties.

3. Your Rights

As an owner of the personal data, you have the right to choose whether or not to provide your personal data to the Firm. After providing your personal data, you may contact us in writing to request access, review, supplementation, correction, cessation of collection, processing, utilization, or deletion of your personal data, or to request a copy of your personal data. The Firm will respond in writing within fifteen days of receiving your written reques. When necessary, we may notify you of an extension to respond within thirty days.
